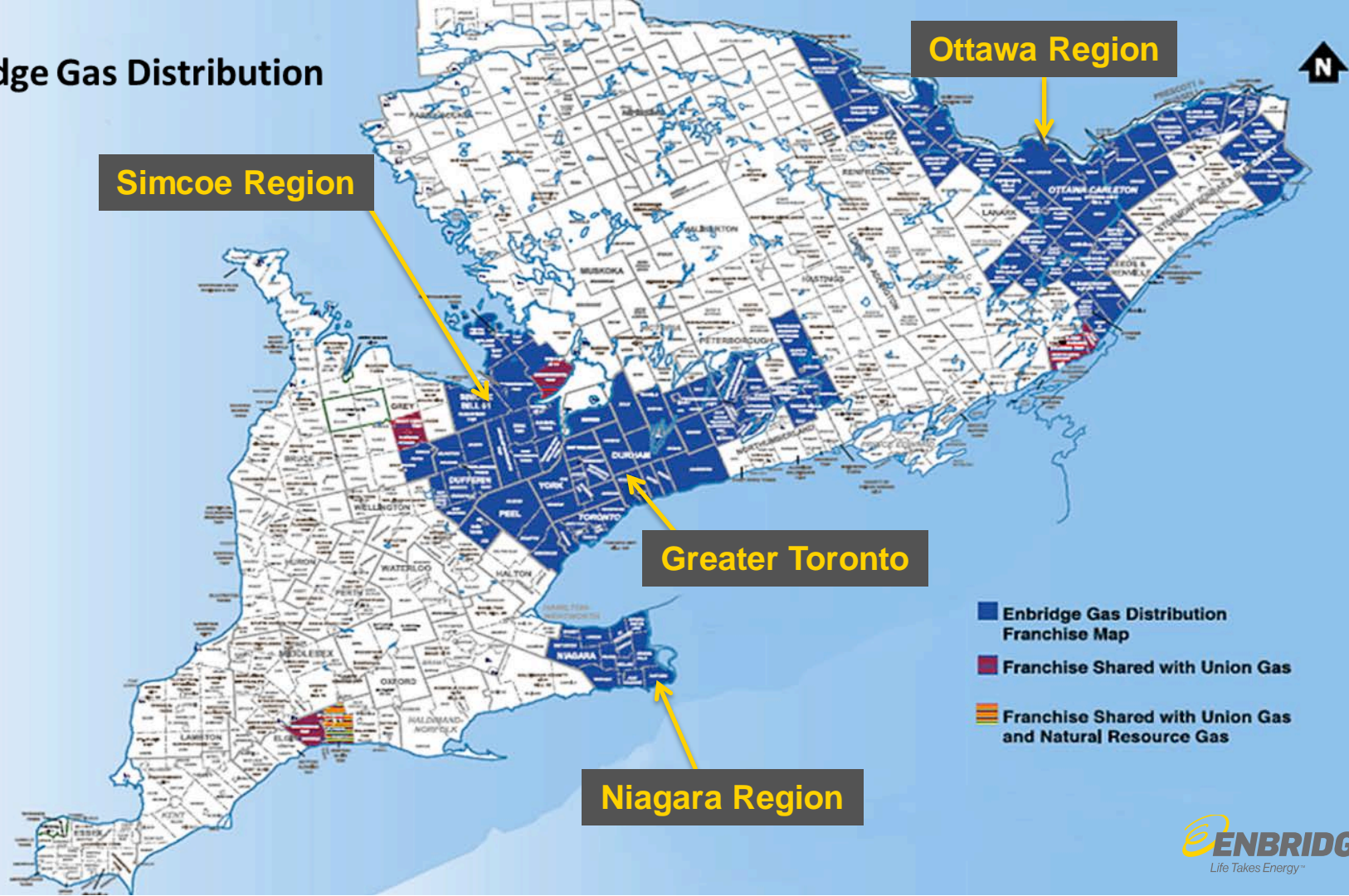

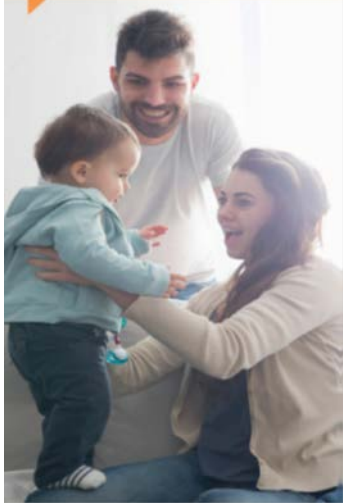


# Assistance for Low-Income Consumers

## The Home Winterproofing Program

Enbridge Gas Distribution

our free Home  
Winterproofing  
Program.



The Home Winterproofing Program is free to all qualifying homes. Enbridge will pay for the cost of the energy-efficiency improvements such as insulation and draft proofing measures.

### Eligibility Requirements

If your household income (before tax income of all household members 18 years or older) is no more than the amounts on the following chart:

| Household Size       | Maximum Gross Annual Income |
|----------------------|-----------------------------|
| One person           | \$32,843                    |
| Two people           | \$40,886                    |
| Three people         | \$50,266                    |
| Four people          | \$61,028                    |
| Five people          | \$69,217                    |
| Six people           | \$78,065                    |
| Seven or more people | \$86,914                    |

# Home Winterproofing Program

## Program Details

- Single family homes occupied by Low Income – detached, semis, row housing
- Community-based organizations contracted to deliver the program
- Free pre and post home energy audit
- Measures: attic, wall, and basement insulation, air sealing, draft proofing
- Heat reflector panels
- Showerheads, kitchen and bathroom aerators
- Carbon monoxide detectors



# Affordable Housing Multi-Residential Program

## Program Details



### PROGRAM OFFER

- Building assessment
- Enhanced financial incentives for capital upgrades and/or replacements
- Direct install for in-suite measures
- Energy audit subsidy
- Resident engagement

### TARGET CUSTOMER

- Building owners and property managers of multi-residential buildings, generally defined as OBC Part 3
- Social and assisted housing
- Non profits and co-ops
- Shelters and supportive housing
- Income qualified buildings located at census defined and municipally informed priority needs neighborhoods

# Affordable Housing Multi-Residential Program

Free Offers (Direct Install)

## 2 in-suite retrofit measures available:

- **Low-Flow Showerheads**
  - 1.5 GPM (gallons per minute) or less
  - Existing showerheads must be  $>2.5$  GPM
- **Heat Reflector Panels**
  - Buildings must be heated with Natural Gas
  - Suites must be heated with hydronic units



# Affordable Housing New Construction

Residential and Commercial Program offered

- Provides affordable housing builders and developers with incentives and services to encourage the construction, renovation and rehabilitation of high-performing, energy efficient affordable housing buildings.
- “Affordable Housing” as defined by government sponsored programs such as IAH.

## Building Eligibility:

- OBC Part 9- Single Family type of dwellings
- OBC Part 3- Multi-residential buildings
